Please note that the following fees based on College Bylaw 6 are subject to change without notice.

APPLICATION FEE

All students who apply for admission or re-admission must pay a **\$30.00** application fee. This fee is payable at the time of application and is non-refundable.

FULL-TIME STUDENTS (Canadian citizens and landed immigrants)

A full-time student is one who is enrolled in at least four (4) courses or (180 hours of class) per semester.

A part-time student is one who takes fewer than 4 courses, or fewer than 180 hours of class per semester. This student must pay \$2.00 per course hour for each course selected.

NON-RESIDENT FEE

In addition to regular fees, if you are a Canadian Citizen but not a Québec Resident, the following Non-Resident Fees must also be paid:

Full-Time = \$1,477.00/semester Part-Time = \$7.21/course hour

FOREIGN STUDENTS

Applicants who do not have Canadian citizenship or permanent residence status may be considered for admission provided they possess a secondary school background which is equivalent to the Québec Diploma of Secondary studies.
